Who can report?	Praxeis Worker (supported & volunteer)	Praxeis Admin & Board	Praxeis Community
What to report?	Any child safety concerns, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • disclosure of abuse or harm • allegation, suspicion or observation • breach of Code of Conduct • environmental safety issues 		

CALL 000 IF A CHILD IS IN IMMEDIATE DANGER

How to report?	STEP 1: Contact Praxeis Safety Officer to assist with reporting process. Ron Turner, 0407 028 545, safety@praxeis.org
	STEP 2: Complete 'Risk of Significant Harm Form'
	STEP 3: Contact appropriate State Child Protection Authority (phone numbers on reverse side of this page)

What happens next?	The Safety Officer will initiate internal processes to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ensure the safety and support of the child, family and workers • clarify the nature of the complaint • commence disciplinary process (if required)

Outcome	Potential outcomes include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • investigation into reported concern • outcome decided • communication of outcome to appropriate parties • policies, procedures updated as necessary
